Principal's Message

Dear Parents,

The first full month of school is over, and we're feeling GOOD! What friendly, happy, loving children you have! It is such a pleasure to see them each day. When I walk down the hall, I am greeted by waving hands and big smiles. When I visit the cafeteria or playground, children greet me with hugs and excited news. What a warm feeling of acceptance I get from these wonderful children. I also appreciate the help and support from you parents and my great staff. We have an amazing Copper Canyon Community! Thank you for all you do!

During the month of October we are focusing on safety. We began in September with our PTA Green Ribbon Week and continue this month with school and bus safety assemblies and PTA Red Ribbon Week. Please take some time this month to reinforce some basic school safety rules with your children, such as the following:

1. When bringing your children to breakfast, please drop them off at the front of the school, and have them walk around to the cafeteria. Do not drop them off in the faculty parking lot.
2. If your children ride bikes or scooters, remind them to never pass parked cars by going into the street. They should pass by going onto the sidewalk until they pass the car(s). They also must walk their bikes and scooters when they reach school grounds.
3. Children AND adults should only use the crosswalks to cross the drop-off/pick-up lanes in front of the school.
4. Please use the parking lot for parking only. You may use the parking lot for dropping off or picking up ONLY if you are willing to park and escort your children to and from the crosswalk. The drive-through lane should never be used for drop-off or pick-up.
5. When in the drop-off/pick-up lane, please be thoughtful of those

waiting behind you. Pull as far forward as possible, have your children hustle out or into the car, and try to leave as soon as possible to avoid making others wait behind you. Please never park and leave your car in the inner drop-off /pick-up lane. The outer drive-through lane should never be used for drop-off or pick-up!

October is also the month to celebrate with our annual Halloween Parade, which will be held on October 31 at 9:00 AM. This is always an exciting time for students, parents, and teachers! Please remind your students that their school costumes cannot include masks or any weapons or facsimiles of weapons (including toys). This requirement is according to District policy and must be observed.

I look forward to another great month, and thank you for your continued support! I invite you to participate in our School Community Council, which will meet this month on Friday, October

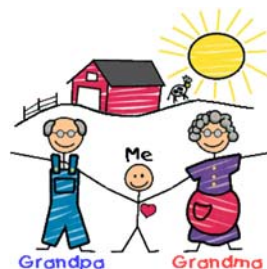
