- We keep 50% of sales - no payment upfront. They send us the cards, we sell them and send back what we don't use and half of the money. I am still waiting to hear back from them on confirmation and how to get the cards, I should have all that on Monday.

- \$20.00 Platinum cards and \$9.00 Basic cards (so sorry, I had my numbers wrong at the meeting since they sent me amounts for interior and exterior washes).

- We decided that our school wide goal would be 200 cards sold rather than a dollar amount since the cards are different prices. Kristy to talk to Patty and okay award if we hit our goal - indoor snowball throwing at Patty (sounds fun!) at school sing-a-long on December 21.

- The class in each grade with the most cards purchased wins a class party. This will happen in January when they return to school. We discussed letting the teachers choose the type of party (ice cream, root beer floats, hot (warm) chocolate, etc). When Kristy and I were in the office going over the logistics and ordering with Jerri we had the idea of doing a hot chocolate bar in the gym on a Friday in January and having each class come in one at a time to get and drink hot chocolate there (maybe add some music for a dance party as well). This would make the class parties easy to manage for the teachers as well as the SCC members organizing it and also hopefully easy clean up. Thoughts?

- The fundraiser will run from November 28th to December 16th - I need to confirm these dates with Mister, but I'm sure it will be fine.

- Kristy has already talked with Jerri about purchasing treats to give to teachers when children turn in their order forms.
- Teachers turn in orders and money from class each morning to the office.
- I have created a Google Doc for sign ups counting the money each day - we need two SCC members each day to do this. The second sheet on the doc has the daily counting amounts to record money received and cards purchased each day. Link is below.
