

School Plan 2025-2026 - Copper Canyon School

Goal #1

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Goal Statement

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Students will show growth in proficiency by end of May 2026 in ELA. We will increase our proficiency in Language Arts on RISE state assessment and our reading on Acadience testing by 1%.

Academic Area

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- English/Language Arts

Measurements

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Summative data from grade level Acadience and RISE scores will be reviewed in vertical collaboration and PLCs. This data will be used to guide reteaching, common grade level assessments, and intervention ideas. We will use the data received from regularly progress monitoring for reading. In addition, we will track and reteach using benchmark RISE practices for ELA. In the previous year, Copper Canyon gained 2% in ELA on RISE proficiency scoring 31.7%. In Acadience proficiency our school lost 1.9% scoring 57.5%. Our year's goal reflects the need to make the goal a 1% gain in proficiency in ELA as our most critical academic need.

Action Steps

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1. We will hire instructional assistants to teach students during daily rotations of theatre, physical education, and STEAM. These instructional assistants will focus putting ELA standards in their lessons. Also, this will allow teachers to collaborate during PLC groups and stay on target with our ELA goal. (\$40,000)
2. We will hire instruction assistants to assist in intervention and teaching ELA strategies during the district phonics and reading program called Walk-To-Read to achieve our reading goal. (\$40,818.01)
3. Teachers will discuss, review, plan, and track their ELA/Reading goal once a month at vertical collaboration.
4. Best practices, common assessments, interventions, and enrichments will be explored or developed during PLC meetings.
5. Teachers will progress monitor regularly and review RISE benchmarks throughout the year.
- Our back of plan is as follows: If funds cannot be spent on hourly personnel, we will purchase reading software to support
- reading instruction in the classroom (\$5,000) and Chromebooks for accessing coursework that facilitates reading (\$15,000).
